



The month of January focusses on cervical cancer elimination. The World Health Organization has given the **90-70-90** targets by 2030: 90% of girls to be fully vaccinated with the HPV vaccine by age 15, 70% of women to undergo cervical cancer screening tests, and 90% of women with cervical cancer to be treated.

ICS is doing just that - we are advocating for vaccination, screening thousands of women and ensuring treatment for those with precancerous lesions.

February saw widespread participation in World Cancer Day events, including hair donations, awareness sessions, walkathons, and a book release.


